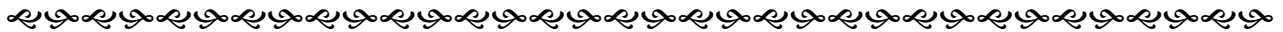
As we approach the High Holiday season and we want to take the opportunity to wish you all
