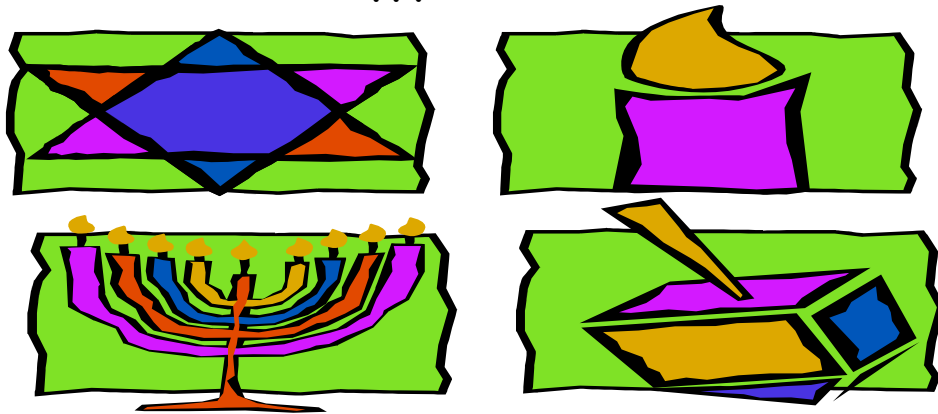
KKJ
